This architect's remodeling project demonstrates the flexibility and design available options from ATAS. Aesthetically, the architect envisioned a continuous line from the roof to wall and was able to achieve this concept with the Dutch Seam panel. To make the bend at the change in plane, the standing seams were carefully snipped, and cut seams were waterproofed by tightly overlapping and riveting a small secondary seam cap over the cut seam. The panels were applied over plywood that was protected by an ice-shield membrane on the roof and a water-resistant barrier wrap on the wall. This project shows the creativity available with metal for roofing and wall panels.
